Why are different types of heat exchangers used in food processing?

Rotating blades continuously scrape the heat transfer surface, preventing product buildup and ensuring efficient heating or cooling. This helps maintain product quality, improves heat transfer efficiency, and enables reliable processing of products that would be difficult to handle in conventional heat exchangers.
