DO YOU KNOW

What's the difference between Pasteurization and Sterilization?

A: Both processes improve food safety, but they serve different purposes.

- Pasteurization uses moderate heat (e.g., milk at 72°C for 15 seconds) to destroy harmful microorganisms while preserving taste and nutritional quality. Since some microorganisms may survive, pasteurized products usually require refrigeration.
- Sterilization uses much higher temperatures (typically above 100°C, such as UHT at 135–150°C for a few seconds) to destroy virtually all microorganisms and spores, resulting in a much longer shelf life.
